Notice for the National Means-Cum-Merit (NMMSE) 2021 Selected Candidates

School District wise selected merit lists of students of NMMSE, 2021 have already been published in scholarships.wbsed.gov.in. As per guideline of Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, every selected student has to register on National Scholarship Portal (NSP2) / (https://scholarships.gov.in) which remain open during July/August every year. In this respect, it is to be mentioned here that until and unless a selected student furnishes relevant information in the online form in NSP2 in time he/she will not be eligible for availing the said scholarship.

So, the selected students of the State level National Means- Cum- Merit Examination (NMMSE) 2021 shall have to register themselves using the option "New Registration" on National Scholarship Portal (NSP2)/(https://scholarships.gov.in) using his/her Basic details (such as-Name, Father's name, Date of birth ,Scholarship category (Pre-Matric), 'scholarship' scheme etc). After successful registration, a 17 digit unique ID will be generated in favour of each student. Then he/she has to submit online form using the option "Log in to apply 2022-23" using his /her example-WB202223XXXXXXXXX in NSP2/ digits (17)ID (for seventeen (https://scholarships.gov.in). Before final submission of online form, student has to select the scheme 'National Means- Cum- Merit Scholarship' which will appear at the 2nd page of the form. After final submission of the application by student, Institute level & District level verification is required for each submitted application of student at NSP2. So, each student is requested to contact with the Head of the Institution immediately for verification of the online application by Institute Nodal Officer (INO). For any query he/she may contact with the office of District Inspector of School (Secondary Education) of his/her district and Head of the Institution/Nodal Teacher of his/her Institution.

N.B: Students are advised not to withdraw his/her application if scheme name (NMMSE) does not appear/available at the end of the application. They are advised to contact the office of District Inspector of Schools (SE) of his/her district immediately.
